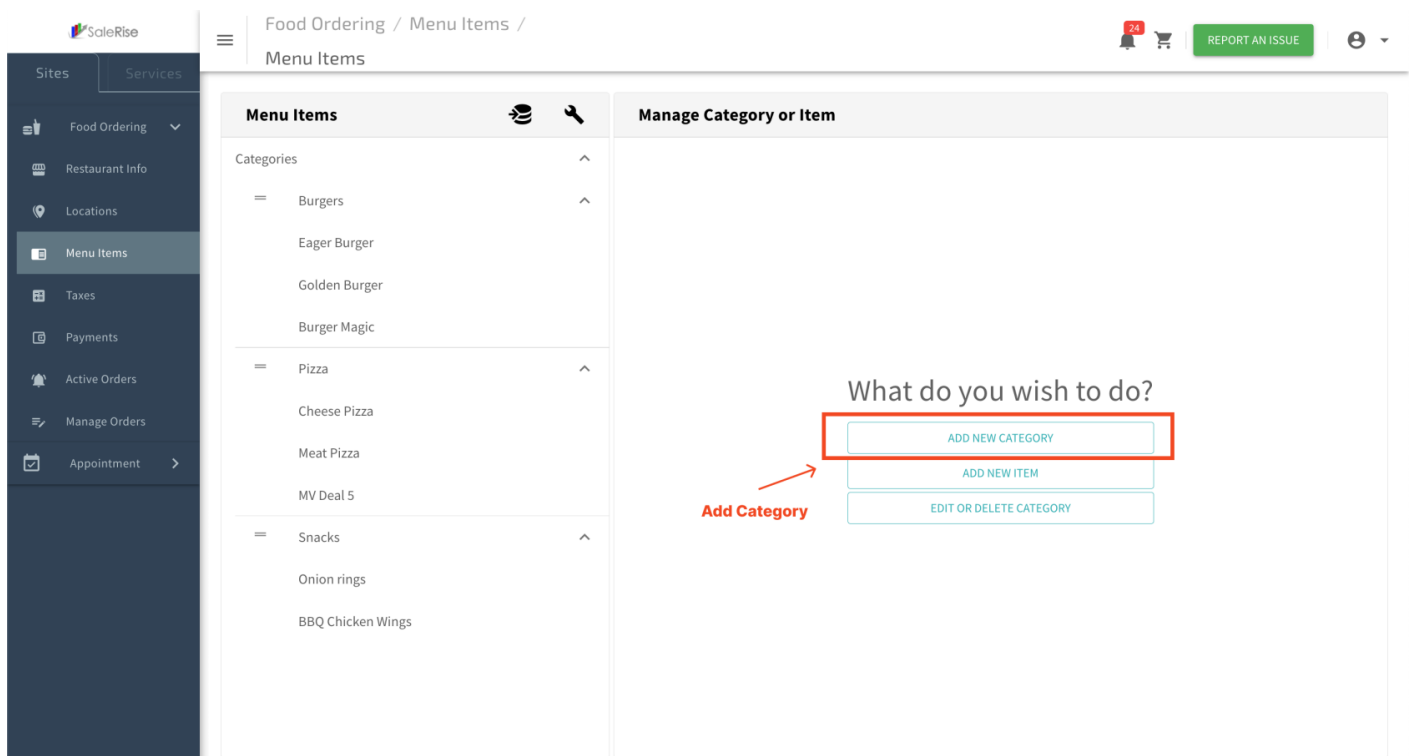
Add Categories

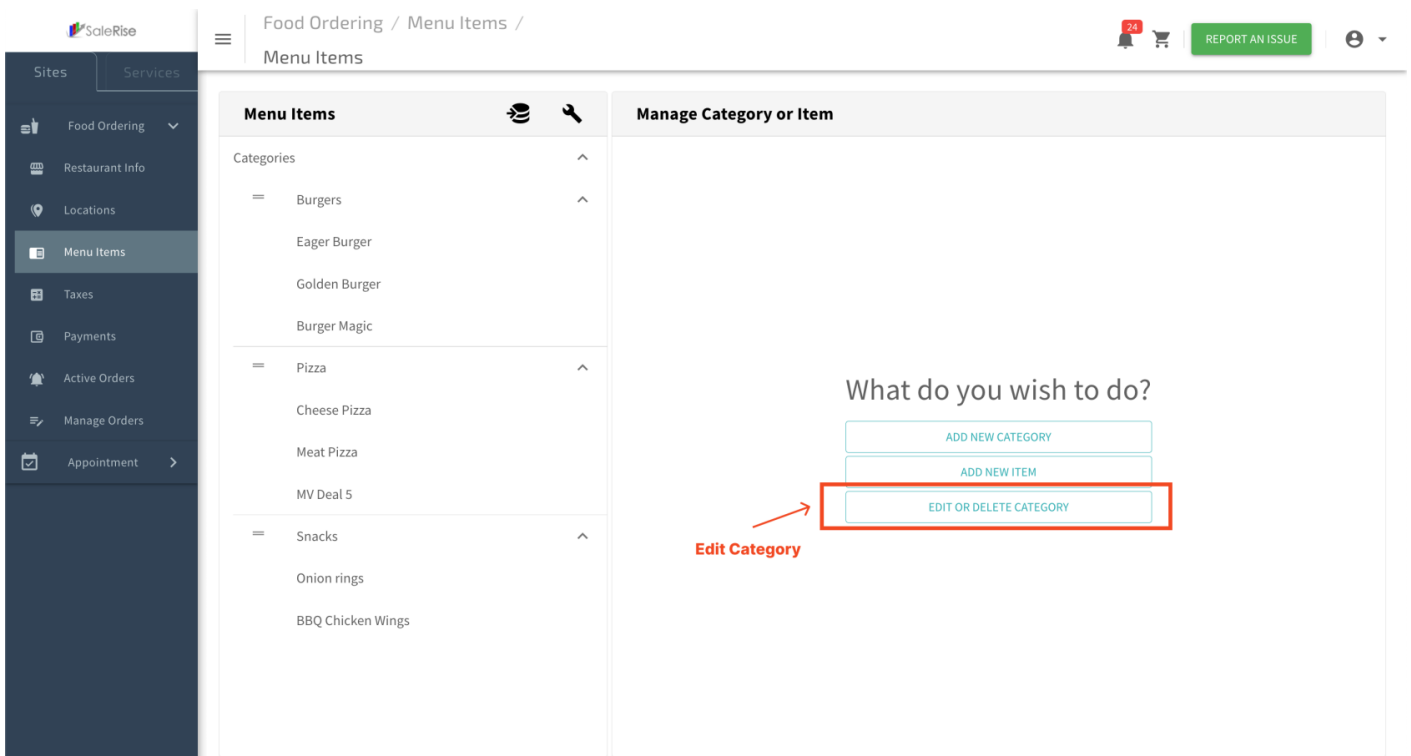

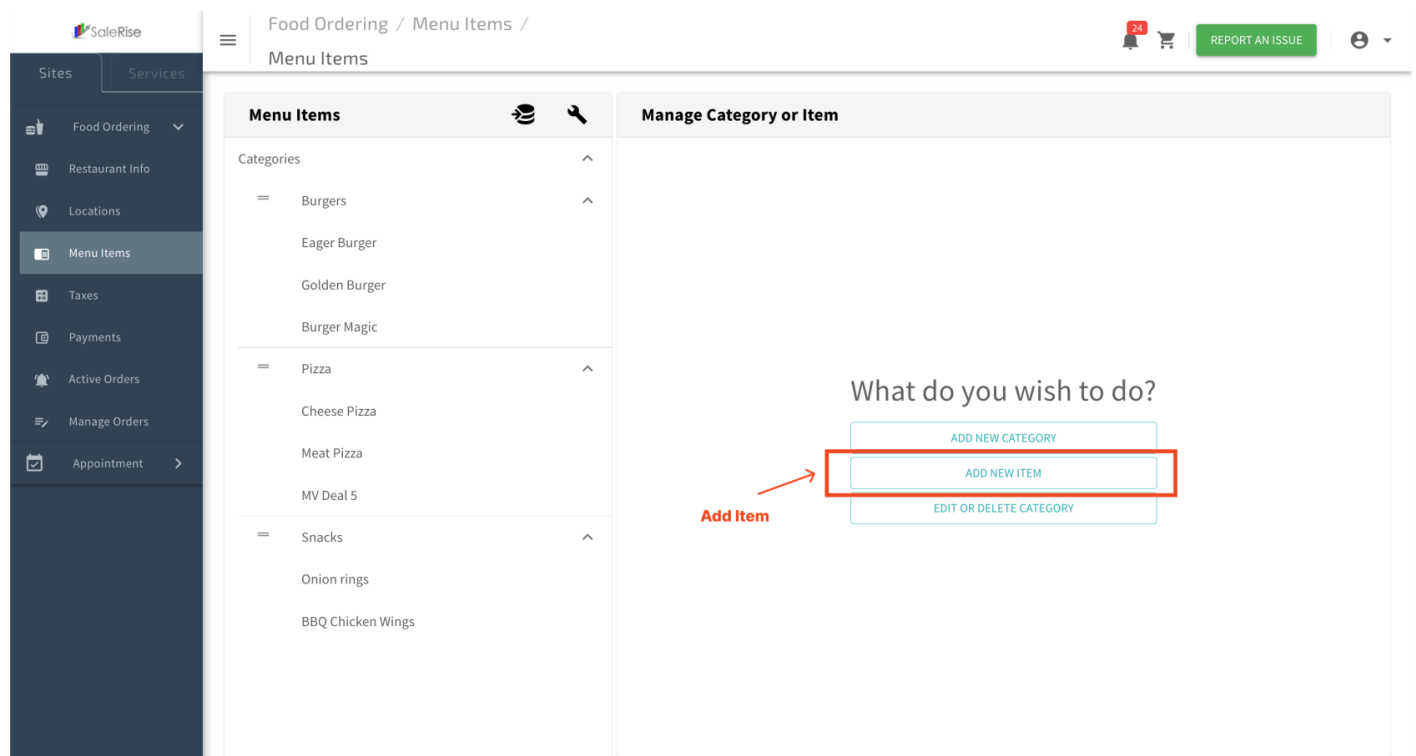
